

An analysis of the factors contained in the project package, as well as the factors contained in Implementing Order 3-41 indicates a No Measure is appropriate for the Goods and Service portion of this contract due to the lack of certified firms in the required commodities. An attempt was made to assign a SBE/G goal for the concrete finish coating material specified for this project, however, the SBE/G certified firms in commodities 31530 (Coatings, Protective (For Masonry Including Concrete floor)) and 75000 (Road and Highway Building materials) responded as not able to provide the FDOT approved material.
