An attempt was made to assign a SBE/G goal for the concrete finish coating material specified for this project, however, the SBE/G certified firms in commodities 31530 (Coatings, Protective (For Masonry Including Concrete floor)) and 75000 (Road and Highway Building materials) responded as not able to provide the FDOT approved material.
