Tree disposition and installation of new trees, sod, and plant materials and restoration as needed.

Estimated Cost: \$571,520.00

Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) is requesting that the General Contractor be in business at least five years, having completed at least two projects similar in size and scope to the subject project, with a Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) Certification held by Owner, principal or direct employee of the company actively engaged in the scope of work.

Due to the specialized nature in the scope of the work involved. PROS respectfully requests that SBD consider a 6.49% SBE Construction Goal for Site Preparation Contractors, Poured Concrete Foundation and Structure Contractors, Fencing and Plumbing Contractors. Landscaping services are approximately 15% of the project. PROS' believes that the site work, concrete sub-trade, fencing and plumbing can be performed by SBE Construction single trade firms without the required experience. The rest of the work will require the experience detailed above.
