Keep existing pump station wet well and replace existing pumps, cables and guilds as shown on plans. Keep existing valve box but replace all piping & valves as per plans. Provide 24 hour pump station bypass installation, replace existing electrical control panel as per plans and coordinate with FPL for new electrical service and run new conduit and cables to transformer as required. Replace concrete curbing around existing pump Station Island. Cut and
