We respectfully request that you consider our recommendation for an SBE-Cons No-Measure.

This project worksheet is a resubmittal. All items remain the same as per the previous project worksheet submitted on January 30, 2020.

## General Description of Work:

CONTRACTOR shall review all documents, specifications, plans and scope of work provided by Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation, and Open Spaces Department for Hobie Island North Side Shoreline Roadway Protection of Rickenbacker Causeway. Work under this Contract includes furnishing of all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment and performing all operations required to construct the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents. Work includes but is not limited to shoreline stabilization, beach re-nourishment, new seawalls, new storm water management system, new pavement for parking and parkways, new paved bike lanes and trails, new paver walkways, guardrails, and new extensive landscapes in upland area. It also includes removal of invasive vegetation, clearing and grubbing, removal of retaining wall and concrete berm south side of Hobie Island along the Rickenbacker Causeway frontage road eastbound. If any changes are required due to conflict of design and or field conditions, the Engineer will make the final determination. The Contractor and all subcontractors, under this Contract, are prohibited from performing any work, other than specified in the Contract and/or directed by the Engineer, within the limits of the project site, without prior written notification to the Engineer. This includes any work for private or commercial entities.

Estimated Total Value: \$7,650,400.00

## **Project Criteria:**

This project contains Federal Grant monies that require the following:

- Full and open competitive bidding
- No State or Local Government Geographical Preferences
- Davis Bacon Wages

An analysis of the CSBE Program Ordinance 97-52, amended and I.O 3-22 has been conducted and the Department suggests an SBE-Cons **No-Measure** due to the Federal requirements contained in the funding guidelines. The Department further suggests using the 7360 contract to be able to conform to Federal requirements.

A race neutral Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) statewide aspirational goal of 10.65% percent exists for FHWA-assisted contracts. The Contractor shall comply with the requirements pursuant to 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 26 as implemented by the approved FDOT DBE Program.
