The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) is forwarding this memorandum to Miami-Dade County Internal Services Department's Division of Small Business Development for informational purposes regarding Contract No.: CIP097-DTPW20-CT2 – Construction Services for the State Road (SR) 836 Express Bus Service – Park & Ride Bus Terminal (Panther Station) project. As a result of DTPW's Office of Civil Rights (OCR) analysis of the workload based on the anticipated project's scope of work and cost estimate, a 17.00% Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal has been assigned by OCR for this project. The funding source for the project is Federal Transit Administration and People's Transportation Plan Bond Program. The construction cost estimate for this project is \$6,718,375.65, which includes a 5.00% contingency allowance account.

Scope of Services

DTPW has a need to obtain construction services for the SR 836 Express Bus Service – Park and Ride Bus Terminal (Panther Station) with station roadway improvements along SW 8th Street between SW 112th Avenue and SW 109th Avenue. The work includes, but is not limited to: furnishing all supervision, labor, materials, equipment, tools, services and incidentals necessary for the construction of the Panther Station Bus Terminal facility and associated Roadway Improvements as depicted in the construction documents.

In addition, the Contractor must meet the below requirements:

- Miami-Dade County Contractor's Certification is required in one of the following categories: General Building Contractor, or other categories as applicable to Chapter 10 of the Miami-Dade County Code, or State of Florida General Contractor's License.
- Bidders must be able to demonstrate, through prior experience, the ability to construct projects of similar size and scope, as described in the project's Summary of Work. Bidders shall provide documentation that demonstrates their ability to satisfy all of the minimum qualification requirements.
