<p><b>SCOPE OF WORK/DESCRIPTION:</b> The project consists of roadway improvements to Bay Vista Boulevard from NE 151 Street to Gwen Margolis Boulevard. Improvements include, but are not limited to, roadway widening from 4 lanes to 6 lanes from NE 151 St to NE 145 St, stormwater drainage system including overflow to bay, sidewalks, curb and gutter, signing and pavement markings, bike lanes, lighting, and potential wetland impacts and contamination.</p> <p>As part of this contract the contractor shall construct a mid-block traffic signal in the vicinity of the cross walk (approximately Station 40+80) in front of Tracy and Alonzo Mourning High School. The work also includes but is not limited to providing all geotechnical, survey, and design services necessary to produce the required construction documents, engineering plans, temporary traffic control plans, project permitting, public involvement plan, and all project coordination, supervision, labor, materials, tools, and equipment needed for completing the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.</p>			
<p><b>LICENSES:</b></p> <p>At the time of Bid and pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida (the County), Florida and these Solicitation and Contract Documents, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active Certificate of Competency as a General Engineering Contractor or as a Specialty Engineering Contractor, commensurate to the requirements of the Scope of Work, in engineering crafts to include paving engineering work. The specialty contractor shall subcontract with a qualified contractor any work which is incidental to the specialty but is specified in the aforementioned Code as being the work of other than that of the Engineering specialty for which certified.</p> <p>Pursuant to Section 255.20, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and in lieu of the above, the County may consider a bid from a Bidder that is a duly licensed contractor in good standing that has been pre-qualified and considered eligible by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) under Section 337.14, F.S. and Chapter 14-2, Florida Administrative Code, to perform the work described in the contract documents. Contractors seeking consideration under this paragraph shall submit along with the bid documents for review and consideration, current copy(ies) of their FDOT Certificate(s) of Qualification, Certification of Work Underway, and status of Contracts on Hand. Acceptable FDOT qualification(s) necessary to perform the work specified in the project's scope of work shall include Flexible Paving and Drainage Work Classes.</p> <p>Additional Information – Permits, Licenses, Certifications, and General Regulations</p> <p>Permits that are issued by DTPW for construction within the public right-of-way, as well as additional permits, which may be required by other municipalities or agencies, including those required for tree removal, will be the responsibility of the Design - Builder.</p>
