This is a request for Review Committee (RC) approval of the proposed Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) goal in order to proceed with soil boring installation and sampling (drilling) under the E14-RER-03 Professional Services Agreement for Project #006-D14/03-CEI, Phase 2 Environmental Site Assessment at the Future Park and Ride Site at US1 and SW 112 AVE, on behalf of the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW)

The subject project consists of the installation and sampling of eight soil borings (drilling), and reporting. This contract, a work order originating from the E14-RER-03 Professional Services Agreement, has been assigned to CB&I Environmental & Infrastructure, Inc. (CBI) who will subcontract the drilling work.

The Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, Division of Environmental Resources Management (DERM), RER staff has evaluated the project and recommends a 0.0% CSBE subcontractor goal for this project (please see attached <u>Analysis for CSBE Goal Recommendation</u>). At this time, DERM is not aware of any CSBE certified soil boring installation/drilling companies on the CSBE list.
