Background:

The project scope of work will consist of the cleaning of Air Handling Unit (AHU) #20 located in the Medical Intensive Care Units (MICU) B in West Wing Building, 4th floor. In addition, provide air duct work cleaning of MICU A in South Wing floors 3 – 6. This specific area will be supplied with a new unit therefore no cleaning of the AHU is required for MICU A. Both areas are on the main campus of Jackson Memorial Hospital located at 1611 NW 12th Avenue, Miami, Florida. The scope includes detailed cleaning of the AHU's supply ducts and return ducts. Vents, VAV boxes, duct heaters and/or coils must also be cleaned. The awarded contractor shall ensure that all OSHA and EPA requirements that are applicable to this scope of services are fully adhered to during the entire project. The awarded contractor shall follow all hospital pre-construction risk assessment and follow all infection control protocols. The estimated cost for this project is no more than \$245,000.00, for both areas.

Minimum Requirements and Special Conditions:

Bidders shall provide evidence of two (2) satisfactorily completed similar project within the past three (3) years. Provide the contact information for a reference along with project details with your bid. Provide reference name, phone number and email address.

Bidders shall be required to possess a valid Certificate of Competency or License for General, Mechanical, A/C Class A, B, or C contracting work issued by State of Florida; or General Mechanical, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning (Unlimited) Contractor by the County Examining Board. Bidders must provide this information together with his/her bid response.

Recommendation:

It is the recommendation of the Procurement Management Department that the Construction Review Committee (RC) approve the Small Business Enterprise Construction (SBE-Cons) set-aside for the above-referenced solicitation.
