Description of Project/Bid:

The Miami-Dade County Public Housing and Community Development (PHCD) department is among the nation's top ten housing agencies managing nearly 9,300 public housing units located throughout Miami-Dade County, in approximately 100 development sites. Public housing units' range in size from zero- and one-bedroom apartments in high rise buildings to multi-bedroom family units. PHCD must maintain all units in an expedited manner.

Currently, work orders serve to identify the source, nature, and priority of maintenance work. They also identify the cost of labor and materials used, time of performance, and provide valuable information on the overall condition of our units.

PHCD is seeking a Maintenance Work Order Contractor for Central Areas, which consist of 32 developments that will create and manage the entire operation of a maintenance work order system, to include performing all maintenance and repair work required for its development sites and ensuring the quality of the work and completion, in a timely manner.

PHCD Central Areas generates an average of about 42 work orders daily. The Maintenance Work Order Manager must have the capacity and organization to complete work orders in all development sites simultaneously and within the required time frame.
