- Crandon Marina 4000 Crandon Blvd. Key Biscayne, FL 33149

To include: Removal / Replacement / Repair Furnish Install Aluminum Fender's / Ladder's to Concrete Wet Slips, Wood Piling Replacement, Fire Hose Cabinet Replacement, Dock Box Replacement, Electrical Pedestal Cabinet / Covers Replacement, Fiberglass Walkway Dock Grates, Light Pole / Fixture / Base Cover Replacement, Scope of Work Per Owners Spreadsheet / Picture Repair / Replacement Document. Restore damaged areas to conditions depicted in plans, and as per permits and typical details with further work identified in the contract documents for RPQ: HI – 999999-17-011, Project: 999999-17-011.
