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## SCOPE OF WORK

# AWNING IMPROVEMENTS Colonel Zubkoff Head Start and Early Head Start Center 55 NW 199 ST Miami Gardens FL, 33169 Project # SA022616ZAW

#### INTENT

Requirements in this "Scope of Work" serve as a direction to the Contractor for the replacement of damaged canvas on awnings located at Colonel Zubkoff Head Start and Early Head Start Center. The Contractor shall perform all services in accordance to building industry/professional standards of skill, care and diligence adhered to by reputable, first class contracting firms and shall conform to generally accepted professional practices.

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Miami-Dade County intends to: repaint the exterior of the North County Head Start Center at 3201 NW 207 ST Miami Gardens FL, 33056. This includes, but is not limited to removal of all canvas material from 9 awnings, inspection to structural frames and repairs if needed, and repainting of frames; requirements below are the basis for this refurbishment. The refurbishment shall use only high quality materials.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

## A. Description of work

- 1. The Contractor shall remove the canvas fabric from 9 different awnings, leaving frames in place. (See attached pictures)
- 2. The Contractor then will inspect each frame for damage, rust or any other item requiring repairs.
- 3.Once repairs are finished, all frames are to be repainted. (Color to be determined)
- 4. Once paint has dried, install new canvas coverings. (Color to be determined)

## Location, Type, and size of awnings (Site visit mandatory to confirm sizes and locations)

- 1. Dome 5 each, 54.00 Wide, 24.00 Height, and 27.00 Projection
- 2. Long Dome 1 each, 618.00 Wide, 64.00 Height, 60.00 Projection
- 3. Straight Slope 1 each, 179.00 Wide, 32.00 Height, 216.00 Projection (Left corner is rounded)
- 4. Three Level Straight Slope arched, 1 each (See Drawing)
- 5. Straight Slope ½ Oval 1 each, 918.00 Wide, 36.00-48.00 Height, 274.00 Projection

#### **B. SITE CONDITIONS**

- 1. The Contractor shall conduct his work so as to interfere as little as possible with center business, determine the center normal working conditions and activities and in progress and shall conduct the work in the least disruptive manner. All work must be performed in such a manner as not to inconvenience building occupants. A schedule must be preapproved by the center Director, before any work is performed.
- 2. The Contractor shall secure and pay for all permits, inspections and licenses necessary for the execution of his work.
- 3. The Contractor shall do all the work and furnish all the materials, tools, equipment and safety devices necessary to perform in the manner within the time specified. The Contractor shall complete the entire work to the satisfaction of the State and in accordance with the specifications herein mentioned, at the price herein agreed upon. All the work, labor, and equipment to be done and furnished under this contract, shall be done and finished strictly pursuant to, and in conformity with the specifications described herein and any directions of the State representatives as given from time to time during the progress of the work, under the terms of this contract.
- 4. The Contractor shall at his own expense, wherever necessary or required, furnish safety devices and take such other precautions as may be necessary to protect life and property.
- 5. The Contractor shall bear all losses resulting to him or to the Owner on account of the amount or character of the work, or because of the nature of the area in or on which the work being done is different from what was estimated or expected, or account of the weather, elements or other causes.

## C. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The contractor will rectify any damage to all areas on completion of the works.
- 2. The contractor shall supply all materials and labor in order to complete the works.
- 3. All waste material to be taken from site and disposed of by the contractor.
- 4. Site is to remain tidy at all times and cleaned up on completion of works.
- 5. All work to be carried out in a workmanship like manner.
- 6. All Documentation regarding warranties, guarantees and instructional literature are to be given to the Project Manager.
- 7. Any Change Orders are to be priced and approved in writing by Project Manager before proceeding with the work.
- 8. All measurements are to be confirmed by the contractor on site.

NOTE: Any damage caused by the Contractor or his contractors is to be made good at the Contractor's expense.

#### **CONTRACTOR PROVISIONS**

The Contractor shall supply everything necessary for the execution and completion of the work including paint, brushes, rollers, drop sheets, sandpaper, fillers, sealants, scrapers, thinners, tints, color charts, masking tape and material, ladders and scaffolding. Site preparation and installation performance shall be in accordance with industry standards, OHSA, EPA Lead Safe standards, and all other Federal, State, and local building codes and standards
