The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, furnishing all material, labor, and equipment necessary for the construction of RAS Pump Stations Nos. 1 through 5, Electrical Building RAS Nos. 1 & 2, Electrical Building RAS Nos. 3, 4, & 5, the Odorizing Control Building and Electrical Substations 9 and 10 at the Central District Wastewater Treatment Plant. The project also includes the rehabilitation of the RAS Pump Stations and generally includes the replacement and/or refurbishment of existing physical equipment to a condition approaching that of new, the construction of the new Electrical Buildings, and Substations 9 and 10 to house proposed motor control centers (MCCs), variable frequency drives (VFDs) and other electrical components; Installation of new air conditioning and air filtration units to Electrical
