Description of Project/Bid:

This project consists of the construction of a new one-story building occupying approximately 26,657 square feet of total constructed area, fully air-conditioned, reinfornced masonry or concrete block structure. The new center will include capacity for 60 emergency shelter beds with space for future growth; kitchens to facilitate multi-family meal preparation; laundry; communal spaces; pet kennel; security entrance feature; generator, and secure outdoor play spaces. The new facility will incorporate accessible design standards to accommodate residents with disabilities. The new center is designed to attain a minmum LEED Silver certification.

Reasons for Recommendation

SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE - CONSTRUCTION

An analysis of the factors contained in Section VI. C. of Implementing Order 3-22 indicates that a 25.64% Small Business Enterprise - Construction (SBE/CONS) Subcontractor Goal is appropriate for the trades of Site Preparation Contractors (3.50%-Earthwork), Roofing Contractors (5.03%-Thermal/Moisture Protection), Plumbing, Heating and Air-Conditioning Contractors (5.93%-Plumbing) and Electrical Contractors and Other Wiring Installation Contractors (11.18%-Electrical).

SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE - GOODS

An analysis of the factors contained in section VIII. B. of Implementing Order 3-41 & Ordinance 14-41 indicates a 2.00% Small Business Enterprise -Goods (SBE/G) Subcontractor Goal is also appropriate for this contract in Construction Materials (2.00%) (15010). The SBE/Goods Subcontractor Goal can be met by First Tier (Prime Contractors) and Second Tier (Subcontractors) certified SBE/Goods firms.
