## **RECOMMENDATION:**

This is a request for Small Business Development (SBD) to approve the subject project in order for the Department to proceed with the approval to obtain a project worksheet for the OPF RTR M2C Road and Facilities, Project No. X-032B. The Minority Affairs Division and the User have evaluated the subject project and recommends an <a href="mailto:SBE/Construction Program Goal of 7% and an SBE/Goods & Services Goal of 0.53%">SBE/Construction Program Goal of 7% and an SBE/Goods & Services Goal of 0.53%</a>. Breakdown of Services to be performed are attached.

The Term of project will be for Six (6) months. The Estimated Cost for this project will be \$348,600.00. Please note: This project is Privately Funded.

# **PROJECT SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

This project encompasses a total of seventy (70) acres of land at Opa-Locka Executive Airport. It is bound by Wright Road to the North, Lejeune Road to the West, Douglas Road to the East and Langley Road to the South.

Phase 2 of this project includes two buildings, the Guardhouse and the Storage Building. The eight hundred and seventy-five (875) square foot Guardhouse functions as the main entry point for all members and guests. This single-story structure features a security office, employee break room, single stall restroom and cart parking area. The 28,026 square foot Storage Building is a preengineered metal building that will serve a multitude of uses in the future. Interior Buildouts are not part of this scope.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Contractor is required to be licensed and Insured in the State of Florida and Miami Dade County
- Contractor must have a minimum of fifteen (15) years of experience
- Contractor must provide and maintain a detailed schedule (Gantt Chart) which highlights the critical path of the project and critical milestones
- Minimum Insurance Requirements for the Contractor are as follows:
  - o General Liability \$1,000,000 Each Occurrence and \$2,000,000 Aggregate
  - Property Damage \$2,000,000
  - Bodily Injury \$2,000,000 Each Occurrence
  - o Automobile liability \$1,000,000 Each Person and \$1,000,000 combined single limit

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- Minimum Bonding Requirements for the contractor are as follows:
  - o Contractor must provide a Payment bond and Performance bond for the entire sum they are contracted for.
- Contractor must be OSHA certified
- Contractor shall be responsible for managing any as-built drawings associated with this Agreement. All as-built drawings shall be generated from the original set of Contract Documents furnished to Contractor at the start of the project. As-built drawings are required as an electronic submittal (CAD) prior to final payment.
