This solicitation will establish a contract for commonly used batteries as well as, establish a list of a pre-qualified vendors to participate in future spot market purchases. This contract has a estimated value of \$475,000 for six years.

An analysis of the factors contained in the project package, as well as, an analysis of Implementing Order 3-41 indicates the SBE measures noted below are appropriate for this contract.

- -SBE Set-Aside (Group 2) for projects up to \$100K: Where there are three (3) or more certified SBE firms available in an established pre-qualification pool, the work order competition must be sheltered among those firms.
- -Bid Preference (Group 1) for projects up to \$100K: 10% Bid Preference to should be applied to certified SBE firms when a set- aside is not attainable. All projects valued over \$100K should be submitted to SBD for review and determination of the applicable SBE measure. There are twelve (12) certified SBE firms in the applicable commodity code.
