SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

2.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract for the purchase of various Frozen Fruit Juices for Miami-Dade County.

2.2 TERM OF CONTRACT

This contract shall commence on the first calendar day of the month succeeding approval of the contract by the Board of County Commissioners, or designee, unless otherwise stipulated in the Blanket Purchase Order issued by the Internal Services Department, Strategic Procurement Division. The contract shall expire on the last day of the sixtieth month.

2.3 METHOD OF AWARD

This solicitation shall establish the following groups:

- Group I: Apple, Grape and Orange Juice
- Group II: Cranberry Juice

Award of this contract will be made on a group by group basis to the lowest priced, responsive, responsible Bidder. In order to be considered for award, Bidders must submit an offer for all items within a group. 2.4 PRICES

Awarded Bidder(s) shall hold prices for no less than twelve (12) months from the effective date of the Contract. Awarded Bidder(s) may request a price adjustment annually. Such request should be submitted, at least ninety (90) days prior to the anniversary month of the Contract effective date. The County may consider price adjustments based on the Producers Price Index, as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for the following Series Id: PCU31141131141116, frozen fruit and vegetable manufacturing frozen concentrated juices, excluding orange juice.

It is the Awarded Bidder's responsibility to request any price adjustment under this provision. The County reserves the right to reject price adjustment requests or to negotiate prices. In the event that the Awarded Bidder does not comply with the price adjustment terms, the initial pricing provided upon award will be utilized for that Contract term.

2.5 **DELIVERY**

All deliveries shall be made in accordance with the details provided in each purchase order. Awarded Bidder(s) shall not hold product. Standard delivery timeframe should be within 17 days of confirmation that the order has be received. All deliveries shall be made in accordance with good commercial practice and all required delivery timeframes shall be adhered to by the Awarded Bidder(s); except in such cases where the delivery will be delayed due to acts of nature, strikes, or other causes beyond the control of the Awarded Bidder(s). In cases of delays, the Awarded Bidder(s) shall notify the County of the delays in advance of the original delivery date so that a revised delivery schedule can be appropriately considered by the County.

- Must notify the County of all recalled items within 24 hours knowledge that the item has been recalled.
- Shall be responsible for pick-up, disposal, and replacement of all items that are subject to recall.
- Shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in connection to the recall and replacement of items.
- Shall refund the purchase price paid by County for such items. Replaced items
 must meet the specifications of the original delivery and must be of equal or greater
 value.

3.3 FROZEN FRUIT JUICE SPECIFICATIONS

All frozen fruit juice provided as a result of this solicitation shall have no signs of having been defrosted and shall be frozen at the time of local delivery. All frozen fruit juice shall meet the following specifications:

Group 1:

3.3.1 Apple Juice (non-foil seal)

Size: 4 ounces, paper/cardboard carton with non-foil seal.

Shield - Pasteurized 100% apple juice from concentrate packed under continuous USDA inspection. Product to be kosher certified. Bidder shall also provide a brand and product code for each item.

3.3.2 Grape Juice (non-foil seal)

Size: 4 ounces, paper/cardboard carton with non-foil seal.

Shield - Pasteurized 100% grape juice from concentrate packed under continuous USDA inspection. Product to be kosher certified. Bidder shall also provide a brand and product code for each item.

3.3.3 Orange Juice (non-foil seal)

Size: 4 ounces, paper/cardboard carton with non-foil seal.

Shield - Pasteurized 100% orange juice from concentrate packed under continuous USDA inspection. Product to be kosher certified. Bidder shall also provide a brand and product code for each item.

3.3.4 Cranberry (non-foil seal)

Size: 4 ounces, paper/cardboard carton with non-foil seal. Shield – Pasteurized, minimum of 15% cranberry juice with sweeteners added, but no preservatives and no other juices, packed under continuous USDA inspection.

Product to be kosher certified. Bidder shall also provide a brand and product code for each item.

3.4 REFRIGERATED EQUIPMENT

The Awarded Bidder(s) shall ensure that any carrier used in the transportation of product is properly insulated, and contains mechanical or thermostatically temperature control refrigeration equipment at all times while delivering and storing the product(s). Such equipment shall be capable of maintaining temperatures at 0 degrees F, or lower.
