Center Hung Corner Displays Replacement

SCOPE OF WORK:

Looking for a vendor to supply and install quality displays and associated controllers for the Center Hung Console as follows:

APPROXIMATE PROJECT COST:

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Purchase one (1) of the 17.64' x 37.80' Upper Corner Displays. This display will be divided into four (4) 8.82' x 15.75' displays and installed on the Center Hung as replacements for the current ones.
- B. Supply of indoor quality displays and associated display controllers as further defined herein.
- C. Supplied display controllers/processors as further detailed herein.
- D. Electrical Panels for 24/7 operation (no remote on/off control).
- E. On-site spare parts package consisting of 2% LED units, Power Supplies, Receiver Cards and Cables.
- F. Redundant controller is being provided in lieu of controller spare parts.
- G. Import Duty and transportation to site.
- H. System documentation / User Manuals.
- I. Technical support via telephone at NO CHARGE for the life of the system for Mitsubishi Electric supplied equipment.
- J. On-site project manager during installation.
- K. On-site maintenance and training on supplied equipment at time of installation.
- L. Removal and disposal of existing displays.
- M. Installation of new displays including secondary support to mount to the owner's primary structure.
- N. Stamped engineering drawings of provided structure.
- O. Unloading and staging of displays at the site.
- P. Labor and equipment to physically install provided displays onto owner provided primary structure.
- Q. Assembly and installation of the new displays at site.
- R. Complete test and set up of the display screens.
- S. Final commissioning by qualified Mitsubishi Electric Engineer.
- T. Disposal of all packing materials.

TIMELINE:

- Procurement of materials and installation of must be completed within ninety (90) days of vendor approval.
- Vendor must coordinate install date with Director or Vice President of Operations.
- Vendor must submit a schedule of anticipated workdays to Director of Operations for approval and must account for events as follows:
 - Event Days – crews allowed onsite from 7am–3pm when the event occurs in the evening;
 - Crews will not be allowed onsite when an event occurs in the morning and/or afternoon (e.g., Matinees and school shows); and
 - Non-Event Days – crews allowed onsite for extended hours as needed.

WARRANTY:

- Manufacturer to provide a limited warranty of seven (7) years on all materials used from the date of installation.

REQUIREMENTS:

- The proposed Vendor must have the following experience and certifications:
 - Must be a firm with at least ten (10) years of successful experience with projects of similar scope.
 - Vendor shall provide a list of a minimum of five (5) facilities (facility, contact name, title, address and current phone number) where the Vendor has provided projects of equivalent size and scope within the last five (5) years.
 - Vendor must have minimum ten (10) years of experience for technicians, installers, and fabricators working with their firm.
 - Provide U/L certification under Vendor’s name.
 - Vendors’ heavy machine operators must have proper certification as required.
 - Meet all deadlines to ensure successful implementation.

INSURANCE:

- Vendor shall purchase and maintain during the entire project and for two years after project completion insurance with the minimum limits and coverage shown below from insurance companies acceptable to (“BPL”). BPL has the right to reject unacceptable insurance carriers.

- Vendor shall carry standard ISO General Liability coverage, written on an occurrence basis including Completed Operations. Coverages on an occurrence basis shall be maintained without interruption from date of commencement of the Vendor’s Work until date of final payment or date coverage is required to be maintained after final payment to the Vendor, whichever is later. The coverage must be endorsed to name BPL, City of Miami, and Miami-Dade County as additional insureds on a primary and non-contributory basis.
