RFI#026294_22 Dressing Room and Wet Areas Tile Replacement - Scope of Work

Furnish material and labor to install 2inch X 2inch tile for restroom wet areas.

APPROXIMATE PROJECT COST:

SCOPE OF WORK:

- Supply labor and materials to install approximately 1800 sq ft of tile to include rounded edge tile to match existing wet areas and baseboard.
- Supply labor to grind existing epoxy flooring to establish a base for installation
- Remove any restroom partitions as needed to perform tile installation

WARRANTY:

- Contractor must provide one year warranty on workmanship and material performance

TIMELINE:

- Lead time on material shall not exceed one (1) week.
- Work to be performed within four (4) open day period.
- Contractor must submit a schedule of anticipated workdays to Director of Operations for approval and must account for time constraints as follows:
 - Performing all duties after hours (10pm to 7am) no exceptions.
 - Crews will not be allowed onsite when an arena event occurs

RESTRICTIONS:

- The proposed Vendor must have the following experience and certifications:
 - Vendor shall provide a list of a minimum of three (3) facilities (facility, contact name, title, address, and current phone number) where the Vendor has provided tile installation projects of equivalent size and scope within the last five (5) years.
 - Vendor shall provide ten (10) tile installation projects of equivalent size and scope for at least five (5) years.
- Proof of completed projects must be submitted at time of proposal.
- The potential vendor must possess CTI (Certified tile Installer) certification.

INSURANCE:

- Vendor shall purchase and maintain during the entire project and for two years after project completion insurance with the minimum limits and coverage shown below from insurance companies acceptable to ("BPL"). BPL has the right to reject unacceptable insurance carriers.

- Vendor shall carry standard ISO General Liability coverage, written on an occurrence basis including Completed Operations. Coverages on an occurrence basis shall be maintained without interruption from date of commencement of the Vendor's Work until date of final payment or date coverage is required to be maintained after final payment to the Vendor, whichever is later. The coverage must be endorsed to name City of Miami, and Miami-Dade County as additional insureds on a primary and non-contributory basis.
