Description of Project/Bid: The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a service contract to provide all necessary labor, transportation, material and equipment to furnish a comprehensive program for the testing, inspection, and certification of various fire rescue equipment for Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Department (MDFR). The resultant contract will ensure that all fire rescue equipment utilized by MDFR will have the proper qualifications to comply with the recommended American Society for Nondestructive Testing (ASNT), National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standards, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), and Manufacturers' Recommendations.

Reasons for Recommendation

The estimated value of contract RQIDI700084 is \$900,000.00 with a contract term for one (1) year with a five (5) one (1) year options to renew.

An analysis of the factors contained in the project package, as well as, an analysis of Implementing Order 3-41 and the Verification to Bid process indicates a Bid Preference is appropriate for Group 1, 2, and 3 due to the unavailability of SBE firms to meet the project's requirements.

Group 4 - Prequalification pool the SBE measures is indicated below:
 Bid Preference: Where there are less than three (3) certified SBE firms available in the established pre-qualification pool.
 SBE Set-Aside: where there are three (3) or more certified SBE firms available in an established pre-qualification pool, the work order competition must be sheltered among those firms.

As of 5/11/2017 there are fifty-nine (59) certified SBE firms in the applicable commodity codes.


