SECTION 2 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

2.1 <u>PURPOSE</u>

This Request to Qualify (RTQ) will establish a pool of pre-qualified Submitter(s) for the purchase of fire hydrants and associated parts in conjunction with the needs of Miami-Dade County. Entry into the pool is not a contract between Miami-Dade County and any Submitter, but an acknowledgement that the included Submitter(s) meet the qualifications as outlined throughout this RTQ. The pool(s) shall be open for Submitters to qualify at any time after the initial RTQ opening date.

DEFENITIONS

- A. Request For Quote (RFQ) An invitation where pre-qualified Submitters are invited to quote on a specific product or service.
- B. Submitter shall refer to anyone responding to this Request to Qualify.
- C. Submittal shall refer to the form submitted in response to this Request to Qualify.
- D. Work Order Proposal Request (WOPR): a solicitation where pre-qualified bidders are invited to quote on a specific product or service, evaluated and awarded based on best value rather than upon the lowest price.

2.2 <u>TERM</u>

The pre-qualification pool will be established on the first calendar day of the month succeeding approval by the Board of County Commissioners, or designee, unless otherwise stipulated in the Notice of Award Letter which is distributed by the County's Internal Services Department, Procurement Management Division, and contingent upon the completion and submittal of all required documents. The pre-qualification pool shall expire on the last day of the last month of the three (3) year period.

2.3 QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Submitters who meet the following qualification criteria will be placed on a list for participation in future competitions:

A. Submitters shall demonstrated experience providing Fire Hydrants. As evidence, submitters(s) are required to provide at least two (2) letters of reference from their clients. Each letter shall include the following: contact's name, telephone number, and e-mail address. The letters shall ascertain to the County's satisfaction that the submitter has sufficient expertise.

Submitters shall provide all of the specified information, documents and attachments listed above with their submittal form as poof of compliance to the requirement of this RTQ. However, the County may, at its sole discretion and in its best interest, allow Submitters to complete, supplement or supply the required documents. It shall be the sole prerogative of the County as to the number of Submitters who will be included under this RTQ. During the term of this RTQ, the County reserves the right to add or delete Submitters as it deems necessary and in its best interests.

2.4 ADDITIONAL GROUPS

The County reserves the right to add additional groups (with applicable qualification criteria) to the RTQ which are not listed within this solicitation. The Internal Services Department, Procurement Management Division will solicit the industry and award said group on a competitive basis.

Warranty may apply if so specified in the Request for Quotations.

2.6 INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE

Section 1.21 (Insurance Requirements) does not apply, proof of insurance is not required in order to be pre-qualified under this RTQ. Insurance requirements will be detailed in the subsequent RTQ or WOPR.
