SCOPE OF WORK/TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

3.1 SCOPE OF WORK/TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

It is the intent of this solicitation to identify and make available expeditious hazardous material removal, associated demolitions and related construction services for Miami-Dade County (County) as described in the Contract. Emergency response shall also be required for emergency conditions that require immediate attention.

The Work may include asbestos abatement; air quality remediation including mold remediation; contaminated soil removal, transportation and disposal; demolition and reconstruction as needed; removal and installation of storage tank systems; Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB) transformer removal; lead paint removal; all petroleum hazardous material handling; and removal or abatement of anything that is or maybe considered an environmental hazard, remediation, code violation work, and/or any environmental work assigned by the Department, and all work necessary to accomplish same or appurtenant thereto.
