
WHO: 5<sup>th</sup> grade elementary school students located in Miami-Dade County Public Schools

### Contest Rules

- Artwork must be original! Students are invited to use their talents to illustrate artwork that concentrates on Florida lifestyle and activities. Artwork will be judged on creativity, legibility and adherence to guidelines. Artwork containing computer-generated graphics, photographs, collages, 3-D artwork or trademarked art will be disqualified.
- Artwork must be drawn horizontally (landscape) on 8½" x11" plain white paper.
- Students can use crayons, watercolors, poster paint, colored pencils, or magic markers to create the artwork. Reflective materials, i.e. glitter, gold stars, cotton balls, magazine pictures or fabric glued to the art are prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- Artwork should not be folded.
- All entries must contain an official entry form. Part I is filled out by the teacher and part II is filled out, signed and dated by the student's parent or guardian. The completed entry form must be submitted with the student's artwork. Any form not signed by the parent/guardian will be disqualified.
- Submitted artwork is NOT returned.

### How do I enter?

Fill out the entry form completely and save it in PDF format.  
Scan and save the artwork as a PDF or jpeg file. Name each document as follows: School code\_student last name\_student first name.

**All entries must be received no later than February 9, 2024.**

**Any artwork not following these guidelines will be disqualified.**

- Students can use crayons, watercolors, poster paint, colored pencils, or magic markers to create the artwork. Reflective materials, i.e. glitter, gold stars, cotton balls, magazine pictures or fabric glued to the art are **prohibited** and will result in disqualification.
- All entries must contain an official entry form. Part I is filled out by the teacher and part II is filled out, signed and dated by the student's parent or guardian. The completed entry form must be submitted with the student's artwork. Any form not signed by the parent/guardian will be disqualified.
- Artwork should not be folded when submitted.
- Submitted artwork is **not** returned.
