

Pursuant to R-454-14, attached please find the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) February 2021 monthly report on bus passenger shelter illumination for shelters located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County (County).

Bus Passenger Shelter Illumination and Repairs (LED lighting upgrade):

- There are 820 bus passenger shelters in the County with a backlighting advertising box that provides illumination at the shelter.
- As of February 2021, 783 bus shelters (95.48 percent) are illuminated. Maintenance and repairs of both illuminated and non-illuminated bus shelters are made in an ongoing process.
- The vendor (Outfront Media) has an ongoing preventative maintenance program in place for the inspection of all new LED lighting system components to ensure that the bus shelters illuminate during the evening hours.

Bus Passenger Shelter Maintenance:

- Outfront Media maintenance staff continues to repair vandalized bus shelters located throughout the County, with 63 glass panels replaced in February 2021.
- 48 batteries were replaced in a total of 48 illumination systems during the month of February 2021.
- Preventive electrical and mechanical maintenance was performed in a total of 116 shelters in February 2021.
- Bus Passenger shelter # 615 located at NW 47 Avenue/OP # 28355, going south, near side of the intersection, Commissioner District # 1; and Bus passenger Shelter # 357 located at NW 87 Avenue # 3737, going north, middle of the intersection, Commissioner District # 12 have been temporarily removed due to a road improvement projects. Bus shelters in question will be reinstalled as soon as we get notification that the construction work in the area has been completed, and after verification that the ROW available left at the sites is enough to install the shelters back and be ADA compliance at the same time.
