

Pursuant to R-454-14, attached please find the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) March 2021 monthly report on bus passenger shelter illumination for shelters located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County (County).

Bus Passenger Shelter Illumination and Repairs (LED lighting upgrade):

- There are 815 bus passenger shelters in the County with a backlighted advertising box that provides illumination at the shelter.
- As of March 2021, 779 bus shelters (95.48 percent) are illuminated. Maintenance and repairs of both illuminated and non-illuminated bus shelters are made in an ongoing process.
- The vendor (Outfront Media) has an ongoing preventative maintenance program in place for the inspection of all new LED lighting system components to ensure that the bus shelters illuminate during the evening hours.

Bus Passenger Shelter Maintenance:

- Outfront Media maintenance staff continues to repair vandalized bus shelters located throughout the County, with 77 glasses panels replaced in March 2021.
- 36 batteries were replaced in a total of 36 illumination systems during the month of March 2021.
- Preventive electrical and mechanical maintenance was performed in a total of 111 shelters in March 2021.
- Bus Passenger Shelter #s 778,779,780,781 and 782 located at Coconut Grove Metrorail Station, Commissioner District # 7; have been temporarily removed due to a Metrorail Station Renovation Project. As soon as we get notification that the Metrorail Renovation Project work has been completed. We will verify that the ROW available to see if we are able to install the Bus Passenger Shelters back.
