Pursuant to R-454-14, attached please find the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) September 2022 monthly report on bus passenger shelter illumination for shelters located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County (County).

Bus Passenger Shelter Illumination and Repairs (LED lighting upgrade):

- There are a total of 1219 bus passenger shelters installed within the boundaries of Unincorporated Miami Dade County.
- As of September 30/2022, 977 bus shelters (80,14 % percent) are illuminated. Maintenance and repairs of all bus passenger shelters are made in an ongoing process.
- The vendor (Outfront Media) has an ongoing preventative maintenance program in place for the inspection of all new LED lighting system components to ensure that the bus shelters illuminate during the evening hours.

Bus Passenger Shelter Maintenance:

- Outfront Media maintenance staff continues to repair vandalized bus shelters located throughout the County, with 84 glasses panels replaced in September 2022.
- 36 batteries were replaced in a total of 36 illumination systems during the month of September 2022.
- Preventive electrical and mechanical maintenance was performed in a total of 84 shelters in September 2022.
