

Pursuant to R-454-14, attached please find the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) October 2022 monthly report on bus passenger shelter illumination for shelters located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County (County).

Bus Passenger Shelter Illumination and Repairs (LED lighting upgrade):

- There are a total of 1230 bus passenger shelters installed within the boundaries of Unincorporated Miami Dade County.
- As of October 31/2022, 987 bus shelters (80,24 % percent) are illuminated. Maintenance and repairs of all bus passenger shelters are made in an ongoing process.
- The vendor (Outfront Media) has an ongoing preventative maintenance program in place for the inspection of all new LED lighting system components to ensure that the bus shelters illuminate during the evening hours.

Bus Passenger Shelter Maintenance:

- Outfront Media maintenance staff continues to repair vandalized bus shelters located throughout the County, with 63 glasses panels replaced in October 2022.
- 26 batteries were replaced in a total of 26 illumination systems during the month of October 2022.
- Preventive electrical and mechanical maintenance was performed in a total of 102 shelters in October 2022.
- The following new bus Passenger Shelters were installed during the month of October /2022:
