

Pursuant to R-454-14, attached please find the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) January 2022 monthly report on bus passenger shelter illumination for shelters located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County (County).

Bus Passenger Shelter Illumination and Repairs (LED lighting upgrade):

- There are 815 bus passenger shelters in the County with a backlighted advertising box that provides illumination at the shelter.
- As of January/31/2022, 766 bus shelters (93.98 percent) are illuminated. Maintenance and repairs of both illuminated and non-illuminated bus shelters are made in an ongoing process.
- The vendor (Outfront Media) has an ongoing preventative maintenance program in place for the inspection of all new LED lighting system components to ensure that the bus shelters illuminate during the evening hours.

Bus Passenger Shelter Maintenance:

- Outfront Media maintenance staff continues to repair vandalized bus shelters located throughout the County, with 73 glasses panels replaced in January 2022.
- 34 batteries were replaced in a total of 34 illumination systems during the month of January 2022.
- Preventive electrical and mechanical maintenance was performed in a total of 106 shelters in January 2022.
- The following new bus Passenger Shelters were installed during the month of January/2022:
