

Pursuant to R-454-14, attached please find the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) January 2024 monthly report on bus passenger shelter illumination for shelters located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County (County).

Bus Passenger Shelter Illumination and Repairs (LED lighting upgrade):

- There are a total of 1333 bus passenger shelters installed within the boundaries of Unincorporated Miami Dade County.
- As of January, 31 /2024, 1086 bus shelters (81.63 % percent) are illuminated. Maintenance and repairs of all bus passenger shelters are made in an ongoing process.
- The vendor (Outfront Media) has an ongoing preventative maintenance program in place for the inspection of all new LED lighting system components to ensure that the bus shelters illuminate during the evening hours.

Bus Passenger Shelter Maintenance:

- Outfront Media maintenance staff continues to repair vandalized bus shelters located throughout the County, with 49 glasses panels replaced in January 2024.
- 22 batteries were replaced in a total of 22 illumination systems during the month of January 2024.
- Preventive electrical and mechanical maintenance was performed in a total of 101 shelters in January 2024.
- 4 new Cantilever Bus Passenger Shelters were installed during the month of January /202:

Shelter # 1663 located at NW 107 AV/ NW 14 ST, Going South/Far side.

Shelter # 1664 located at SW 137 AV/ SW 136 ST, Going South/Near side.

Shelter # 1665 located at SW 208 Dr/ SW 112 AV, Park and Ride. # 1.

Shelter # 1666 located at SW 208 Dr/ SW 112 AV, Park and Ride. # 2.

- 8 Bus passenger Shelters were removed during the month of January/2024.
