Pursuant to R-454-14, attached please find the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works' (DTPW) January 2025 monthly report on bus passenger shelter illumination for shelters located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County (County).

Bus Passenger Shelter Illumination and Repairs (LED lighting upgrade):

- There are a total of 1367 bus passenger shelters installed within the boundaries of Unincorporated Miami Dade County.
- As of January,31 /2025, 1137 bus shelters (83.17 % percent) are illuminated. Maintenance and repairs of all bus passenger shelters are made in an ongoing process.
- The vendor (Outfront Media) has an ongoing preventative maintenance program in place for the inspection of all new LED lighting system components to ensure that the bus shelters illuminate during the evening hours.

Bus Passenger Shelter Maintenance:

- Outfront Media maintenance staff continues to repair vandalized bus shelters located throughout the County, with 40 glasses panels replaced in January 2025.
- 12 batteries were replaced in a total of 12 illumination systems during the month of January 2025.
- Preventive electrical and mechanical maintenance was performed in a total of 104 shelters in the month of January 2025.
- Five shelters were removed during the month of January 2025. Bus Shelters #s: 1280,1297,1308,1309 and 1310.
- 11 new Bus Passenger Shelter were installed during the month of January 2025.
