

## TECHNICAL RIDERSHIP REPORT

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 332,300 experiencing decreases of 9.8%, 5.4 % and 4.5% from May 2008, May 2007 and April 2009. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 324,300, decreasing by 17.3% from May 2008, by 8.6% from May 2007 and by 5.3% from April 2009. Information by mode is as follows:
- **METROBUS:** Weekday boardings for May 2009 averaged 239,800 decreasing by 12.3%, by 8.8% and by 6.6% from May 2008, May 2007 and April 2009, respectively. The average weekend boardings were 249,900, experiencing decreases of 18.9% from May 2008, of 12.3% from May 2007 and of 3.6 % from April 2009. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot data averaged 1,475 cars decreasing by 2% from the previous year and by 3% when compared to the previous month.
- **METRORAIL:** Weekday boardings for May 2009 averaged 61,400 decreasing by 0.7% from May 2008, however increasing by 8.3% from May 2007, and decreasing by 0.8% when compared to April 2009. The average weekend boarding was 43,100, experiencing a decrease of 8.9% from May 2008, an increase of 7.8% from May 2007 and a decrease of 12.2% when compared to the previous month.
- **METROMOVER:** Weekday boarding for May 2009 averaged 25,800 experiencing decreases of 5.8% from May 2008 and of 4.4% from May 2007, however increasing by 3.6% when compared to April 2009. The average weekend boarding was 28,000, decreasing by 14.6% , 6.4% and 9.1% from May 2008, May 2007 and April 2009.
- **PARATRANSIT:** STS weekday trips for May 2009 averaged 5,300 experiencing a decrease of 8.6% from May 2008, however increasing by 10.4% from May 2007 and by 15.2% from April 2009. The weekend trips averaged 3,300 decreasing by 13.2% from May 2008 and by 5.7% to the previous month.







