### Wastewater Line Replacement


#### **BACKGROUND**

On April 9, 2014, the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida authorized a Consent Decree between Miami-Dade County, the United States of American, the State of Florida, and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, for improvements to the County's wastewater collection system.

#### PROJECTED SCHEDULE

Construction began in April 2015, with an expected duration of four (4) months. Work within the pump stations will continue until approximately August 2016.


#### **PROJECT AREA**

#### **Area Affected:**

- Installation of 12-inch wastewater line along NW 199 Street from NW 37 Avenue to NW 29 Court
- Installation of 8-inch wastewater line along NW 29 Court from Pump Station #0385 (20352 NW 29 Place) to NW 199 Street
- Installation of 8-inch wastewater line along NW 199 Street from NW 29 Court to the Snake Creek Canal
- Installation of 6-inch wastewater line along the Snake Creek Canal from NW 199 Street to Pump Station #0374 (2749 NW 199 Terrace)

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
