Pump Station #0187 Upgrade and Expansion

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) has embarked on a Capital Improvement Program to provide necessary upgrades to the water and sewer infrastructure to continue providing high quality services, protecting public health, and the environment. One of these projects is the upgrade of pump station #0187 in your neighborhood. This project is part of the Consent Decree Program which requires several operational and maintenance improvements to Miami-Dade's wastewater system.

On April 9, 2014, the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida authorized a Consent Decree between Miami-Dade County, the United States of America, the State of Florida, and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, for improvements to the County's wastewater collection system. The upgrade to the Pump Station for Consent Decree project 5.12 is part of this program.

PROJECT INFORMATION / SCHEDULE

Construction at the Pump Station is expected to begin in April 2017 and expected to be completed in fourteen months. Construction work will take place during weekdays from sunrise to sunset. The contractor will take additional steps to minimize impacts, but you may experience some noise and intermittent traffic disruptions due to lane closures or detours. At the conclusion of the project, the roadway areas impacted by the construction will be restored. We thank you for your continued support.

Pump Station #0187 (1 Northwest Boulevard) upgrade:

- Replacement of plumbing and electrical equipment
- Partial demolition and expansion of electrical building including structural upgrades around pumps
- Upgrades to the heating, ventilation and airconditioning system.
- Installation of new valves, pumps, motors, control panel and a bridge crane
- The upgrade will not affect the water or the wastewater services in your area.
- The areas surrounding the construction will be restored at the conclusion of the project.
