Installation of new water pipeline

The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) has embarked on a Capital Improvement Program to provide necessary upgrades to the water and sewer infrastructure to continue providing high quality services, protecting public health, and the environment. One of these projects is the design and installation of a new 36-inch water line located along NW/NE 5 Street from NW 1 Avenue to Biscayne Boulevard.

PROJECT INFORMATION/SCHEDULE

Installation of the new pipeline is scheduled to begin in January 2019. The final completion date is anticipated for May 2019. The construction will occur in five phases:

- Phase 1: NW/NE 5 Street from NW 1 Avenue to North Miami Avenue – January 2019
- Phase 2: NW/NE 5 Street from North Miami Avenue to midblock (between North Miami Avenue, just west of NE 1 Avenue) – February 2019
- Phase 3: NW/NE 5 Street from just east of North Miami Avenue midblock to NE 1 Avenue – February 2019
- Phase 4: NW/NE 5 Street from NE 1 Avenue to NE 2 Avenue March 2019
- Phase 5: NW/NE 5 Street from NE 2 Avenue to Biscayne Boulevard – April 2019

In advance, we thank you for your support as the department works on this necessary infrastructure upgrade.

- New 36-inch water line to enhance the reliability of the system.
- The Department and contractor will work diligently to inform residents and local businesses as construction progresses.
- The project will not affect the water or wastewater services in your area.
- The areas surrounding the construction will be restored at the conclusion of the project.
- There may be temporary lane closures or detours.
- Access to your property will be maintained at all times.
