



PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS TO PUMP STATION 334

6950 Lochness Drive, Miami Lakes, FL 33014



Miami Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) is embarking on a Pump Station Improvement Program (PSIP). The program will provide necessary upgrades to the sanitary sewer collection system pump stations and force mains that provide high quality wastewater services, protecting public health and the environment. One of the first pump stations to be improved in the Town of Miami Lakes is PS 334. WASD will be coordinating directly with the community prior to construction.

PROJECT LOCATION

Pump Station 334 is located at 6950 Lochness Drive. Work will also be completed on the force main that connects the pump station to the existing main at NW 67th Avenue and runs along Lochness Drive.

PROJECT INFORMATION

The upgrade of existing sanitary sewer pump station 334 will not affect the wastewater services in your area. During construction hours, residents should expect minor traffic delays on Lochness Drive. Lochness Drive and the area surrounding the pump station will be restored at the conclusion of the project.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction will begin in early February 2015, with an expected duration of six months. All construction activities will occur during the day time.
