The Miami-Dade County Water & Sewer Department is seeking an experienced Deputy Director to oversee the County's water and wastewater operations. The ideal candidate will implement innovative operational strategies through change management. The Deputy Director is instrumental in achieving the Department's mission of providing high-quality drinking water and reliable wastewater services, promoting water conservation, working to safeguard public health and the environment, and collaborating in the execution of a large-scale capital improvement program for one of the nation's largest metropolitan utilities. Incumbents play an integral role in

the high-level decision-making of daily operations while promoting effective leadership amongst staff. Candidates should possess the following: A minimum of seven years of progressive managerial and administrative experience in the areas of water and wastewater utilities or similar experience in a public enterprise is required. Bachelor's degree in Public Administration, Business Administration, Engineering or another related field. An A-Level License in Drinking Water and/or Wastewater Treatment is required. An equivalent A-Level License in Drinking Water and/or Wastewater Treatment level license from another state may be considered for eligibility.



WASD IN THE NEWS

Liquid Oxygen

Supply chain interruptions due to COVID-19 have impacted supplies of liquid oxygen (LOX). WASD has been able to step in and assist area businesses that are in dire need of LOX for critical sectors such as water treatment or food production.

WIFIA Loans

WASD has been awarded a \$424 million Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (WIFIA) loan to help eliminate the use of ocean outfalls. WASD is the only utility to be awarded four loans through this competitive EPA program.

Smart Wastewater Network

An innovative WASD workplace solution, the Smart Wastewater Network, has been awarded by numerous industry organizations for its pioneering efforts in the wastewater field – including the IOT Evolution Wastewater Product of the Year.
