

- On January 31, 2025, the County provided EPA and FDEP with the 2024 Quarterly Report No.4 as per section IX, Paragraph 32 of the Consent Decree.
- During the week of February 3, 2025, NEIC, EPA and FDEP conducted a site visit to all three wastewater treatment plants. On February 7, 2025 a closing conference was held between NEIC, EPA FDEP and MDWASD to review their findings.
- The Start-up, Commissioning and Acceptance tests for the Thickening and Dewatering Facility at the South District WWTP began on January 6, 2025.
- On March 3, 2025 the County provided EPA and FDEP with the 2024 Annual Report as per section IX, Paragraph 32 of the Consent Decree.
