Summary Minimum Experience and Qualification

The Prime should demonstrate experience using Innovyze Infoworks ICM wastewater hydraulic modeling software for systems including a minimum of fifty (50) pump stations, at least one thousand (1,000) pressure links, and three thousand (3,000) gravity links. Additionally, experience with Innovyze Infowater hydraulic modeling software for systems with a minimum of fifty thousand (50,000) links is preferred. Experience is defined as original model construction or model calibration, and operation of the hydraulic model.

The Prime Consultant should demonstrate successful completion of one (1) water and one (1) wastewater master plan for utility systems with a total projected flow exceeding ten (10) million gallons per day (MGD).

The Prime Consultant should demonstrate knowledge and experience with the County's Consent Decree Order and/or the requirements of the Clean Water Act, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) regulations, including development and renewal of operating permits, and any other applicable regulatory requirements for water and sewer utilities.

The Prime Consultant and/or Subconsultants are preferred to have experience with life-cycle cost estimation analysis and project scheduling.

The Prime Consultant and/or Subconsultants are also preferred to have experience addressing resilience and the impacts of climate change (e.g., sea level rise) on water and sewer infrastructure, including providing recommendations to mitigate these vulnerabilities.

Summary Minimum Experience and Qualification

The Bidder or the Bidder's Subcontractor shall have as a minimum the following licenses:

- 1) Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida and these Solicitation and Contract Documents, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active:
