In addition to licensing requirements, bidders or their specialty contractor is required to demonstrate direct experience in all aspects of horizontal directional drilling, including shaft construction and:

- Bidder shall provide a minimum of five (5) years of experience, under its current business name, in the construction of roadway / horizontal projects of similar scope and scale involving public right-of-way, construction / installation / repair / replacement of main water distribution systems and/or sanitary sewer collection systems, and maintenance of vehicular traffic, supported by references for five (5) projects completed within the past five (5) years.
- Since Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requires on their contracts, all Bidders shall be prequalified by FDOT on 50% of the work, the same shall apply to bidders on this project.
- Bidders shall demonstrate that it has full-time personnel with the necessary experience to to perform the project’s scope of work.
