# **Paving and Drainage Plan Review**

### **Pre-Paving & Drainage (P&D) Application**

Prior to filing a Paving and Drainage (P&D) application, if the property is not legally platted, an approved Tentative Plat or deferred Waiver of Plat must be obtained. Depending on the scope of work, additional zoning-development review processes may be required. If a zoning review is required, then the applicable zoning process must be completed and approved **prior** to the submittal of the P&D application. The Tentative Plat or Waiver of Plat number and approved Zoning process number are required when filing a P&D application. #### **Appointments**

Applicants may meet with staff by appointment prior to the P&D application submittal to obtain information regarding the review process, submittal requirements, and/or discuss deficiencies if any. Appointments can be scheduled between 9 am and 3pm, Monday – Friday by calling 305-375-2141.

### **P&D Application Submittal**

**Online** Applications may be filed online at <a href="https://energov.miamidade.gov/EnerGov\_Prod/">https://energov.miamidade.gov/EnerGov\_Prod/</a> SelfService#/home. First time users will need to create an account.

### **Application Intake Acceptance**

An application will only be accepted once the required documentation is submitted. This includes but is not limited to, the notarized and completed application, payment of fees, verification of approved zoning review process, if applicable, and a Tentative Plat approval or a deferred Waiver of Plat. Also note, if a Traffic Study report is required, it must be approved by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) prior to the submittal of the Paving and Drainage plans (ensure required improvements per Traffic Study are incorporated into the Paving and Drainage plans). Please refer to the Applicant's Checklist for a complete list of required documentation. This review is not technical in nature, instead, it is intended to confirm the plans and the application are accurately completed. Once accepted, the application will then be reviewed for technical completion and sufficiency.

#### **Application Completion & Sufficiency**

The accepted P&D applications will be distributed for review to all the required reviewing agencies, where the application for technical completion & sufficiency review will initiate. Incomplete applications/plans will be deemed deficient, and the applicant will be provided 30 calendar days to address the deficiencies.

Pursuant to Section 125.022 of the Florida Statues, the department may not request additional information and/or corrections to deficiencies more than three times unless the applicant waives this limitation in writing allowing for subsequent re-submittals. The resubmittal may require additional review fees. Please note that the assessed fees provided with this review are subject to change and additional fees may be incurred during the review process.

#### **Re-Submittal**

All re-submittals should be accompanied by the Re-Submittal Application. Please note, if the Re-submittal application does not accompany the plan set all previous reviewing agencies will be activated.

#### **Final Decision**

Once the application is deemed complete and sufficient by all reviewing agencies, then the County will either approve, approve with conditions or deny the P&D application.

Please note that Paving and Drainage plans will not be approved until road closure(s), if applicable, have been approved by the Board of County Commission.

#### **Applicant's Checklist**

The following items must be submitted with any paving and drainage application:

- Application must be filled out completely and properly executed for review consideration.
- One (1) PDF set of Paving and Drainage plans signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer licensed in the state of Florida. Ensure a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer licensed in the state of Florida is included.
- One (1) PDF set of Signing and Pavement Marking plans signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer licensed in the state of Florida, to include in the background the landscape plan, hardscape elements and any other pertinent elements that can impact/affect the intersections sight distance.
- Plans must be signed and sealed in accordance with the guidelines of their respective licensing boards. For details go to <a href="https://www.miamidade.gov/global/economy/permits/digital-signing-sealing.page">https://www.miamidade.gov/global/economy/permits/digital-signing-sealing.page</a>
- Plans must include Engineer Certification statement on the cover sheet.
- Plans must contain a Title Block identifying the project name, project location and include the approvedTentative or Waiver of Plat name and number.
- One (1) PDF set of the drainage report signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer licensed in the state of Florida is included.
- One (1) PDF set of the percolation tests signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer licensed in the state of Florida is included.
- One (1) PDF Tree Disposition Plan signed and sealed by a Landscape Architect, if impacting trees.
- Boundary Survey (signed and sealed, not older than 1 year. Must show all structures and rights-ofway).
- Provide approved Zoning process approval letter and/or approved Resolution letter, if applicable.
- Plan review fees are to be paid upon receipt of the invoice.
- Estimate of Subdivision Bond Form is to be submitted once Paving and Drainage plans are approved and option to upload the form is available in EnerGov.
- If a Traffic Study report is required, it must be approved by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) prior to the submittal of the Paving and Drainage plans.
