Eric Silva, DP&Z, began the meeting with introductions. Silvia Unzueta was nominated as Chair of the Steering Committee and Joe Sagarribay as Vice-Chair. Joe Webb, Parks and Rec., presented the Miami-Dade County Parks and Open-Space Master Plan. Included in the discussion were plans for the two vacant lots, recently purchased, within the Coral Villa Estates Charrette study area.

The following questions, concerns and comments were expressed by the committee members:

- Residents asked about the facilities and programs of the new park.
- Will a playground and dog park fit on the site?
- Children have no place to play
  - They must travel distances along major thoroughfares on bike and that is not safe.
- Is there money to acquire land in the area to build new, bigger parks?
  - Emphasize the connection between Coral Villa and A.D. Barnes Park
    - $\circ$  make traveling to and from these places more enjoyable, safer
- What is the ratio of population to area of parks (sq. ft.)?
- Why do some properties have sidewalks and others do not?
  - This is a major concern for people who take walks, especially those with strollers or the handicapped.
- There is no street lighting in the neighborhood.

Maritza Ortega, Office of Neighborhood Compliance, presented an update on code violations in the area and her office's response to violators.

Eric Silva, DP&Z, presented a review of the comments and concerns taken from the Steering Committee Meeting on 10/27/09.
